

We will be holding the Annual Fire Extinguisher Training with the Peachtree City FD on May 31st @ 1000h (weather permitting). April is Distracted Driving Awareness Month.

Around the Airbase that equates to

vigilance when driving tugs, forklifts, and moving aircraft. Also, be extra cautious driving into and out of the parking areas as we are very crowded.

Please remember to keep the aircraft canopies closed overnight in the Hangar. We've had some severe storms come though (and expect more in April and May). Storm damage to the roof, skylights, and/or sprinkler system could release large quantities of water inside the hangar. A closed canopy could be the difference between a "free wash" and destroyed avionics.

TRAINING FOR VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

WHAT IS THERE TO DO?

We had a wonderful turnout for volunteers at our first event this season which made this event run very smoothly for our guests. Our success is made possible by our volunteers. The efforts put forth by our team make the difference in our events. Many members are unaware of the opportunities available during our events. Here's a short list to give you a better idea.

On-Site Event Responsibilities:

- Pre-event setup this includes cleaning the hangar floor after aircraft are moved, setting up tables and chairs, setting up the stage and sound system, ensuring all supplies are in place, placing parking/event signs, and general cleaning.
- Pre-event support this includes assisting the host party with their setup once they arrive prior to the event, ensuring they have everything they need, and making last minute adjustments to the setup of the tables and chairs.
- Event support this includes greeting guests and directing them through our facility, answering questions about our organization, emptying trash cans, providing support to caterers and vendors, ensuring restrooms stay stocked and clean, operating golf carts to shuttle guests, directing guests for parking, and general tidying during the event. Docents also are a large piece of event support, especially when we have aircraft on display.
- Post-event breakdown this includes stacking tables and chairs, cleaning floors, breaking down stage and sound equipment, emptying trash cans, taking down signage, and restoring facility to operating status.

Off-Site Responsibilities:

*Please note, some off-site events are on an invitation-only basis. Certain functions (not listed below) are limited to qualified individuals such as rides team and marshalling teams.

- Pre-event setup this includes assisting our PX and Rides team to setup our tables and tents, placing signage in designated spots, unloading supplies from the trailer and truck, and ensuring our area is ready to greet guests.
- Event support this includes greeting guests and directing them through what we have to offer, answering questions about our organization and aircraft, assisting PX and Rides team as needed, and ensuring our pilots and Operations teams have supplies such as water and lunch.
- Post-event breakdown this includes packing up supplies, tents, signage, and tables, and assisting the PX, Rides, and Operations team as needed.

CAF Airbase Georgia Warbirds Take to Skies for 2025 Air Shows and Events

Spring is bringing a unique fleet of World War II-era warbirds out of the hangar for a busy 2025 <u>Commemorative Air Force (CAF) Airbase Georgia</u> season of airshows and events. The aircraft will be on display and will provide aerial performances at airports in the United States between March and November. This year's campaign is dedicated to the 80th Anniversary of the end of World War II and 250th Anniversary of the U.S. Navy & Marines.

The season kicked off with the Wings & Things Festival and Fly-In March 22 at Douglas, GA., home to the WWII Flight Training Museum. Airbase Georgia will return to Sun 'n Fun and EAA AirVenture, two of the largest and most heavily attended aviation traditions in the United States. Airbase Georgia's FG-1 Corsair is also scheduled to participate in the extremely popular U.S. Navy Legacy Flight Program which matches today's frontline fighters with their predecessors in close flight maneuvers at air shows nationwide.

CAF Airbase Georgia, based in Peachtree City, Ga., was founded in 1987. The Airbase is one of the largest units of the <u>Commemorative Air Force</u> (CAF). The group maintains and flies seven vintage military aircraft including a P-51 Mustang, an FG-1D Corsair, an SBD Dauntless, an LT-6 Mosquito, a P-63A Kingcobra, a PT-19 Cornell and a T-34 Mentor. Under restoration are an N2S Stearman and P-47 Thunderbolt. The Airbase, composed of more than 300 volunteer members, is a founding partner of the <u>Georgia WWII Heritage Trail</u> launched in 2021. The Airbase is part of the CAF, a non-profit, tax-exempt organization that relies on contributions of time and funds to conduct its mission.
